Your Experience

Springfield: Located in the American Heartland, our city is beautiful, quiet, safe, and friendly.

Housing: Double or triple occupancy housing in campus residence halls (summer) OR at a nearby hotel (winter, fall, and spring).

Food: 19 meals per week provided at campus dining centers (summer) or 14 meals at the campus dining center with hotel breakfast (winter, fall, and spring). Excludes meals on field trips.

Insurance: Health insurance is provided through Missouri State University. Details available upon request.
