### MSU Scholarship Vouchers

Recipients of Board of Governors, Deans, Provost, and the Inclusive Excellence Scholarships receive one \$1,000 education abroad voucher.

- These awards may be applied to tuition, travel, living expenses, or any other costs related to your education abroad program.
- Award is automatically applied to your MSU account after your education abroad participation is verified with our office.
- Dispersed the second week of classes during the semester.

### External Scholarships

#### Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship

- Pell-eligible
- U.S. citizen
- 1 in 4 students awarded \$3-\$5k
- 3 essays required
- **Deadlines: October 5, 2023 & March 7, 2024**

#### Fund for Education Abroad

- \$1k-\$5k
- U.S. citizen
- Awardees are 74% first generation. 84% identify as people of color
- **Deadlines: September 20, 2023 & February 7th, 2024**

#### Boren Awards

- Boren Awards fund study in Africa, Asia, Central & Eastern Europe, Latin America, and the Middle East. Must include language study as a core element for the duration of the grant.

#### Freeman-ASIA Scholarship

- Must have at least a 2.8 GPA and must have been accepted to a study abroad program in select Asian countries.
