
ONLINE LIBRARY (FREE BOOKS)

Ask your professor if that would work!

Here are some things you may want to be mindful of before buying or renting textbooks:

- → Make sure they are the *right textbooks*.
 - ► Check the author(s) and title
 - ► Check the edition
 - ► Check the ISBN
- ◆ Check the date you have to return them (if you are renting) and make sure it is after your final exams
- → Check when you will be needing them and make sure they *arrive before* that
- → Pay attention to the *conditions* of the materials before you order them
- → Be aware that used materials may not come with supplemental materials (e.g., CDs, access codes)
 - ► Check your syllabus and talk with your professor to see whether they will be using any online components or supplemental materials that sometimes come with the textbook
